Considerations and Questions

- 1. Today, we look at the story of how Jesus came to raise Lazarus from the dead.
- 2. Lazarus and his sisters Mary and Martha were close friends of Jesus. They lived in the town of Bethany, less than two miles from Jerusalem.
- 3. The Disciples of Jesus did not want Him to go to Bethany because there were many Jews leaders in nearby Jerusalem who wanted to do harm to Him.
- 4. In the midst of the danger, Thomas expressed considerable courage and loyalty to Our Savior. John 11:16.
- 5. Jesus did not return to Bethany as soon as He received the news of Lazarus' illness. Why do you think that the Savior delayed going?
- 6. When the sisters called out Jesus for not getting there soon enough to save their brother from dying, Our Savior's response was divine.
- 7. How do you feel when your prayerful requests are not answered when and how you want them to be?
- 8. In verse 35 of today's text, "Jesus wept." Why do you think He did so?
- 9. Why did Jesus call Lazarus from the grave by name?
- 10. Have you ever witnessed a miracle or heard directly about one?
