Points of Information - Luke

Luke was a Gentile, not a Jew. He was a medical doctor by profession. In Colossians 4:14, the Apostle Paul refers to Luke as "the beloved physician."

Luke was <u>not</u> one of the Twelve Disciples. He was a co-traveler, dear friend and ministerial colleague with the Apostle Paul.

Points of Information – Luke

The Gospel according to Luke, inspired and guided by the Holy Spirit, is one of the three Synoptic Gospels – along with those of Matthew and Mark. These Gospels closely match one another in content and sequence. Yet, large segments of the Lukan Gospel are unique.

Points of Information - Luke

Luke also wrote the Book of the Acts of the Apostles. In that Book, Luke details momentous events in Christian history: the monumental Day of Pentecost, the stoning of Stephen (the first Christian martyr), the Damascus Road conversion of Saul/Paul and more. It is believed that Luke might have written at least one more Book of Scripture, which has been lost.

Lesson Context - 1

Today's Scriptural segment takes place after our lesson last week, where Jesus surprised and then blessed two men who were walking from Jerusalem to Emmaus.

Luke 24:35 (NLT) SETTING IT UP!

Then the two from Emmaus told their story of how Jesus had appeared to them as they were walking along the road, and how they had recognized Him as He was breaking the bread.

Luke 24:36

And just as they were telling about it, Jesus Himself was suddenly standing there among them.

"Peace be with you," He said.

Luke 24:37

But the whole group was startled and frightened, thinking they were seeing a ghost!

Luke 24:38-39

"Why are you frightened?" He asked. "Why are your hearts filled with doubt?

Look at my hands. Look at my feet. You can see that it's really me. Touch me and make sure that I am not a ghost, because ghosts don't have bodies, as you see that I do."

Luke 24:40-41

As He spoke, He showed them His hands and His feet.

Still they stood there in disbelief, filled with joy and wonder. Then He asked them, "Do you have anything here to eat?"

They gave Him a piece of broiled fish,

and He ate it as they watched.

You are witnesses of all these things.

And now I will send the Holy Spirit, just as my Father promised. But stay here in the city until the Holy Spirit comes and fills you with power from Heaven."
