Lesson Title: The Lord's Supper

Lesson Text: Luke 22: 7 - 23

Study Exodus Ch. 6; 12; Luke 22 – 23 NIV

INTRODUCTION

Jesus came to complete and fulfill what was customary in the Feast of the Passover for hundreds of years.

Unbeknownst to His disciples, the Passover as it related to a sacrificial lamb per the Jewish tradition would be no more.

Jesus expresses his eagerness of this moment to the disciples as they gathered to commune.

- 3) Never forget that The Lord Rose again with omnipotence and He Still Lives Today.

THE PLOT BEFORE SUPPER

Someone came to dinner with an ulterior motive.

They were acting like they were part of the family.

Eating, enjoying fellowship, smiling & acting.

All the while knowing, they made a backdoor deal with the enemy to betray Jesus.

What kind of person would do such a thing? Why?

Luke 22:7-10 NIV

7). Then came the day of Unleavened Bread on which the Passover lamb had to be sacrificed.

⁸ Jesus sent Peter and John, saying, "Go and make preparations for us to eat the Passover."

Luke 22:9-10 NIV

⁹ "Where do you want us to prepare for it?"
they asked.

¹⁰ He replied, "As you enter the city, a man carrying a jar of water will meet you. Follow him to the house that he enters

LUKE 22:11-12 NIV

¹¹ and say to the owner of the house, 'The Teacher asks: Where is the guest room, where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?'

¹² He will show you a large room upstairs, all furnished, Make preparations there.

LUKE 22:13 NIV

" ¹³ They left and found things just as Jesus had told them, so they prepared the Passover.

LUKE 22:14-15 NIV

¹⁴ When the hour came, Jesus and his apostles reclined at the table.

¹⁵ And he said to them, "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer.

LUKE 22:16-17 NIV

¹⁶ For I tell you, I will not eat it again until it finds fulfillment in the kingdom of God.”

¹⁷ After taking the cup, he gave thanks and said, “Take this and divide it among you.

LUKE 22:18-19 NIV

¹⁸ For I tell you I will not drink again from the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes."

¹⁹ And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me."

KEY POINTS TO REMEMBER

- 1. The significance of this Passover is this was the very last supper under the old covenant.**
- 2). Jesus' death, burial & resurrection replaced the Need for a Lamb to shed blood at Passover. Jesus is the ultimate Sacrificial Lamb.**
- 3). The blessing in communion gives us a new covenant and a new remembrance! Luke Ch.22:20**

LUKE 22:19-20 NIVW

²⁰ In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you.

²¹ But the hand of him who is going to betray me is with mine on the table.

LUKE 22:22-23 NIV

²² The Son of Man will go as it has been decreed. But woe to that man who betrays him!" .

²³ They began to question among themselves which of them it might be who would do this.

MATTHEW 26:25-26

24 The Son of Man will go just as it is written about him. But woe to that man who betrays the Son of Man! It would be better for him if he had not been born."

25 Then Judas, the one who would betray him, said, "Surely you don't mean me, Rabbi?"

Jesus answered, "You have said so."
