LESSON CONTEXT

Chapters 1-10 we see organization as the Census was taken. Although free, their history was still fresh in their minds. God was still speaking to Moses giving guidance. The Israelite are free from slavery and on a journey to the promised land. While in the wilderness the negative minded began to grumble about the food & drink they use to have in slavery; while on their way to the promised land.

- 4. Complaining is contagious and spreads like fire.
- 5. The Faith of a few in an almighty GOD will supersede all negativity & evil spirits
