



### **God's Rule Over Nations** Introduction Psalm 47: 1-9

6

Psalms 47 is a bold call to worship and invitation for everyone to acknowledge the sovereignty of GOD above all other gods. in loud and passionate worship, The repetition of sing praises raises the intensity of the Psalms message, The attributes of God are proclaimed; evidence of to His Kingship authority and power are all undeniable.

## LESSON CONTEXT

7

When the Israelites settled in the Promised Land, they were surrounded by idol-worshiping nations and living among people who had numerous gods. The Gentile nations saw their idol gods as rulers. This idea filled the hearts of the Israelites, and they began worshiping the same idol gods, Baal and Asheroth.

## **LESSON CONTEXT**

8

The Moabites, descendants of Lot, lived just to the southeast of Israel, worshiped Chemosh, a god who demanded child sacrifice. King Ahaz, a descendant of King David, burned his own children as sacrifices to foreign gods (2 Chronicles 28:1–3). Molech, the god of the Ammonites, was also worshiped with human sacrifice. **Idolatry leads to separation from YAHWEH.**
