ZECHARIAH 1: 1-2 NIV

A Call to Return to the LORD

- 1. In the eighth month of the second year of Darius, the word of the LORD came to the prophet Zechariah son of Berekiah, the son of Iddo:
 - 2. "The LORD was very angry with your ancestors.

ZECHARIAH 1: 3 NIV

3). Therefore, tell the people: This is what the LORD Almighty says: 'Return to me,' declares the LORD Almighty, 'and I will return to you,' says the LORD Almighty.

ZECHARIAH 1: 4 NIV

4).Do not be like your ancestors, to whom the earlier prophets proclaimed: This is what the LORD Almighty says: 'Turn from your evil ways and your evil practices.' But they would not listen or pay attention to me, declares the LORD.

ZECHARIAH 1: 5 NIV 🚇

5) Where are your ancestors now? And the prophets, do they live forever?

ZECHARIAH 1:6 NIV

"6). But did not my words and my decrees, which I commanded my servants the prophets, overtake your ancestors? "Then they repented and said, 'The LORD Almighty has done to us what our ways and practices deserve, just as he determined to do."

In chapter 7:5-6, God challenges the rituals performed and asks the questions:

When you were fasting for years was it really for me?

Were you not just feasting for yourselves?

ZECHARIAH 7: 8-9 NIV

- 8). And the word of the LORD came again to Zechariah:
 - 9). "This is what the LORD Almighty said: 'Administer true justice; show mercy and compassion to one another.

ZECHARIAH 7:10-11 NIV

10). Do not oppress the widow or the fatherless, the foreigner or the poor.Do not plot evil against each other.'11"But they refused to pay attention; stubbornly they turned their backs and covered their ears.

ZECHARIAH 7:12 NIV

12). They made their hearts as hard as flint and would not listen to the law or to the words that the LORD Almighty had sent by his Spirit through the earlier prophets, so, the LORD Almighty was very angry.

ZECHARIAH 7:12 NIV

13" 'When I called, they did not listen;
So, when they called, I would not listen,' says
the LORD Almighty.

ZECHARIAH 7:14 NIV

14' I scattered them with a whirlwind among all the nations, where they were strangers. The land they left behind them was so desolate that no one traveled through it. This is how they made the pleasant land desolate."

Liberating Lesson

We encounter similar disobedience in our present-day society. Every day, we meet people who harden their hearts to hearing the word of God. However, Zechariah encourages returning to the Lord, leads to a right relationship with and true worship of Him. We must be patient and walk with the Lord. As we do so, He will keep us and encourage us in times of discord.

APPLICATION FOR ACTIVATION

The Holy Spirit fills us with a joy that the world does not give. In times of distress the Lord provides protection for us.

When we are empowered by the Holy Spirit, we are to be witnesses to others to win souls for Christ. This is the mission of the church until the Lord comes again.
