Sanctuary Roof Replacement Project | Frequently Asked Questions

This summer, Allen Temple is undertaking a significant and necessary facilities investment — the replacement of our Sanctuary roof. The following answers common questions about the project, temporary worship arrangements, and what to expect during the construction period.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Why is the Sanctuary roof being replaced?

The current roof is the original roof from the Sanctuary's initial construction in 1981. After decades of faithful service, it has reached the end of its life cycle. Replacing it now is a responsible act of stewardship — caring for the house where God has met us faithfully, so it is ready for generations to come.

Will anything else in the Sanctuary be improved during this time?

Yes - and we are excited to share this good news. Concurrent with the roof replacement, we will be enhancing our Sanctuary floors, pews, screens, and lighting. When we return on August 2, we will step into a Sanctuary that has not only been protected — it has been elevated.

What are the key project dates?

- **June 8 – 13:** Family Life Center Gym is prepared and set up for worship
- **June 14 – July 26:** All worship experiences held in the Family Life Center Gym (*active construction period*)
- **July 27 – August 1:** Move back to the Sanctuary; reset and prepare for worship
- **August 2:** Return to Sanctuary for Worship

Will the Sanctuary building be accessible during construction?

No. Effective June 10, no unauthorized persons will be permitted to enter the Sanctuary building. Please plan accordingly and do not attempt to access the building during the construction period.

WORSHIP DURING THE CONSTRUCTION PERIOD

Where will worship be held during construction?

All worship experiences will be held in the Family Life Center Gym. The space will be fully set up for worship just as we experience it in the Sanctuary. Our Project Team is committed to ensuring the space is prepared with excellence so that the spirit of our worship remains uninterrupted.

Will service times change?

No. Worship service time remains unchanged. Sunday morning worship will continue at 9:30 AM.

Have we held worship in the Family Life Center Gym before?

Yes. We successfully held worship in the Family Life Center Gym during the Sanctuary Platform Remodel in 2012. We have done this before, and we will do it well again.

Is there anything special about the dress code this summer?

Consider this your invitation to relax. During the construction period, we will enjoy *Dress Down Summer* — members and guests are welcome to wear casual clothing that is respectful of a worship space. Come comfortable, come as you are, and come ready to praise.

Where will Sunday School Live be held?

Sunday School Live will move to classroom space within the Family Life Center. The confirmed location will be shared as soon as it is finalized. Stay tuned to the weekly newsletter and church website for updates.

MINISTRY EVENTS & SCHEDULING

Can ministries hold events in the Family Life Center Gym during this period?

Events requiring the gym are being kept to a minimum during the construction period. As is protocol, all ministry events must be approved by Cluster Leaders and scheduled through the Events Desk. We remain committed to accommodating all ministry events as facilities allow.
